How can countries build up a critical mass of professionals that understand the risks and opportunities of the green transition? How can we strengthen policy makers' capacities to design and implement place green economy policies?

The Forum will focus on the issue of learning and skills development for current and future decision-makers, technical staff in Ministries and others involved in policy design and implementation. The overall goal is to scale-up knowledge and skills development for devising green economy solutions that are inclusive and address concerns related to economic competitiveness and employment.

More specifically, The Forum aims to:

Discuss how to identify critical knowledge and skills gaps of policy professionals

Identify examples of effective learning actions in support of an inclusive green transition

Identify and measure the results and impacts of effective skills development

Engage learning institutions such as public administration schools in delivering green economy learning actions

Initiate South-South-North partnerships to exchange information and experience on green economy learning
