



Peru

- The **Second Regional Green Industry Forum** took place in the city of Trujillo on 14 Nov.
- PAGE held a bilateral **meeting with the Ministry of Environment** on 17 Nov on the PAGE Peru 2018 planning process.
- PAGE **participated in two external events:** Ashoka's Social Changemaker Day in Lima, on 14 Nov, with Peru 2021 (private sector and social entrepreneurs), and at the High-level regional forum on the implementation of Convention No.169 on indigenous and tribal peoples, on 23-24 Nov.

Burkina Faso

- In November, 13 regional **consultations** were carried out to collect comments and proposals on the draft National Green Economy Strategy. Experts and regional stakeholders such as regional directorates of key ministries and the Communes were involved. It is expected that the updated National Green Economy Strategy will be adopted during an upcoming stakeholder workshop.
- On 29 Nov, a draft document on creating a **National Commission on Green Economy** was circulated for comments, with the involvement of PAGE and GGGI. The document will be submitted to the Government for adoption.
- PAGE and GGGI are collaborating on the integration of green growth concepts into the National Green Economy Strategy.
- From 27-30 Nov, PAGE conducted a **training of trainers on entrepreneurship** with the participation of 7 trainers from Burkina Faso (2 from the Ministry of Environment and 5 from the private sector), held in Senegal.

Senegal

- The **National Steering Committee** met on 24 Nov to share the annual work plan and to prepare for the forthcoming green economy week.
- On 27-30 Nov, PACEV (national green jobs programme) and PAGE conducted a **training of trainers on entrepreneurship**. 26 participants took part in the training, 18 male and 8 female participants, including 7 participants from Burkina Faso. All reported having enhanced their capacity in IGE related issues through the training.
- 5 officials from Senegal participated in the training program on '**Opportunities for green jobs in the waste sector**' at the International Training Centre of the ILO in Turin, Italy.

South Africa

- On 21 – 22 Nov, PAGE held a workshop on **Scaling Sustainable Trade through South African Value Chains: Organic and Biodiversity-based Agricultural Products Green Economy Industry and Trade**. 28 participants took part into the workshop, 15 males and 13 females. This workshop is aligned with SDGs 12 and 15 by identifying opportunities for organic agriculture and biodiversity-based products for trade and addressed sustainable production systems.
- On 28 Nov, a scoping workshop was held to assess opportunities for **proposing a new PAGE workstream on green economy modelling**. 20 participants attended the workshop.
- On 8th December, an **upcoming event on "Green Economy - Circular Economy - Secondary Resources Economy.... Are We Talking About the Same Thing?"** is going to be held at the Science Forum of South Africa 2017.
