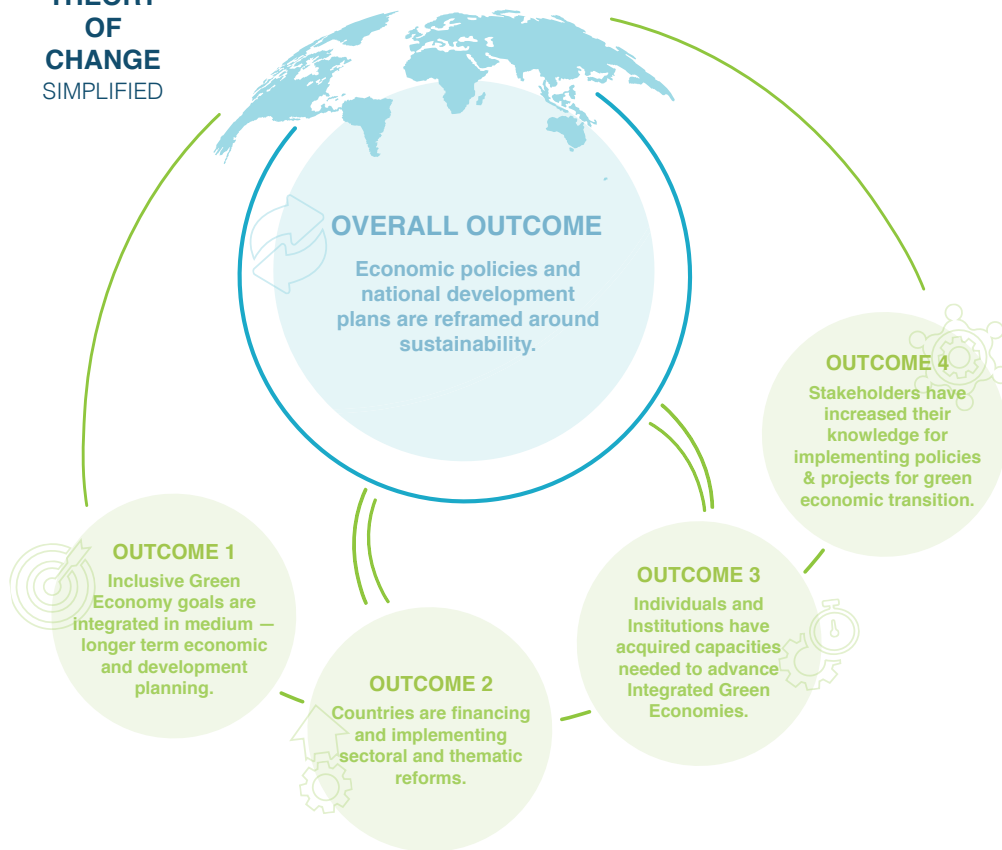

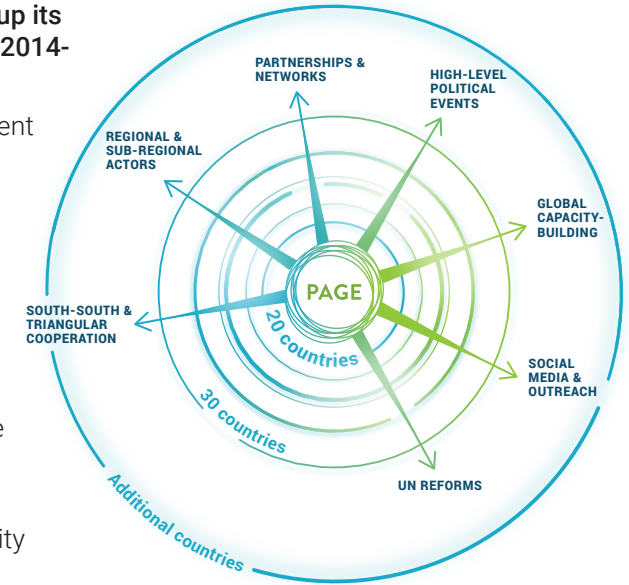

These activities will accelerate the momentum for a sustainability revolution

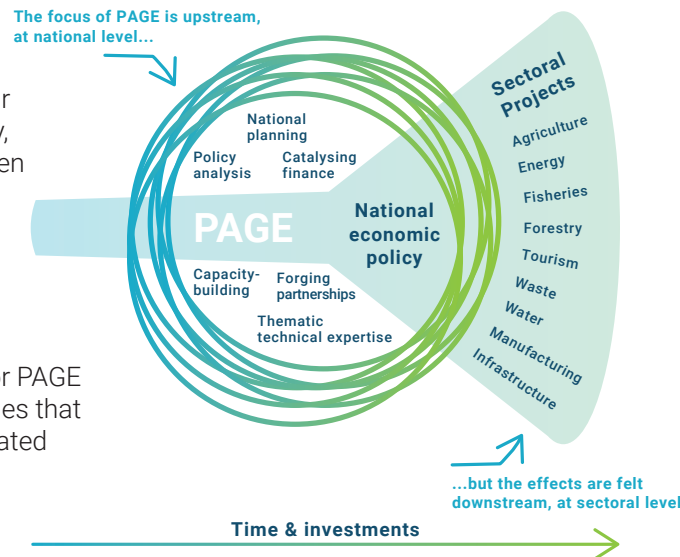
